

## SKILLS COMPETITON

- Players can participate in one individual shooting competition each. The entire team will participate in the Team 3-Point Shootout. Coaches will sign-up players on their Skills Competition Entry Form and submit on Saturday.
- Shooting Contest Tie-breaker: In case of a tie, the participant that reaches the number of successful shots in the shortest number of attempts will be declared the winner. Example: 2 participants tie with 8 successful FT's. Player \#1's $8^{\text {th }}$ successful FT was on the $8^{\text {th }}$ attempt, while Player \#2's $8^{\text {th }}$ successful FT occurred on the $9^{\text {th }}$ attempt. Player \#1 would be declared the winner.


## Team 3-Point Shootout

- Each TEAM will be required to make 30 3-point shots.
- Teams will be timed for the duration that it takes the entire team to make 303point shots (Maximum time of 6 minutes)
- Players will be divided by grade of team and gender



## Individual Free Throw Shootout

- Each player is given 10 free throw attempts.
- Most made attempts wins
- Players will be divided by grade of team and gender
- 2nd Grade will shoot from the 12 ft line



## Individual Timed Spot Shot Competition

- Total of 5 spots marked on the floor.
- Each player will be timed on the amount of time that it takes to make a shot at each location
- Player will be responsible for rebounding their own shots without assistance
